Co-incidentally Ringo had just replaced Pete Best and a section of the audience were shouting "We want Pete!" Hopefully with the pandemic under control we can all get back together to celebrate the world's undisputed greatest ever band.

signed a contract with John, Paul, George and Ringo, the previous contract had been signed by John, Paul, George and Pete, but significantly not by Brian. Ringo of course replaced Pete and The Beatles first single, 'Love Me Do' was released.

The rest, they say is history. Let the Good Times roll as we get together to celebrate another Beatleweek full of fun, frolics and memories of the Fab Four, here in The Cavern Liverpool, "Where it all began".

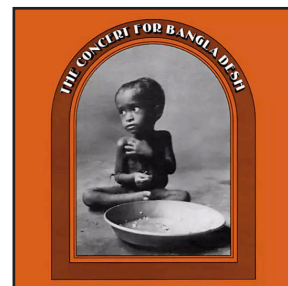
A warm **Welcome Back to Liverpool at Alma De Cuba.** The entertainment will be a mix of Liverpool and International artists. The outdoor patio stage
