Welcome to International Beatleweek 2023 and the biggest Beatles celebration ever. If you have never been before you are in for a treat, and if you have, welcome home!

For 7 days and 7 nights, the music of John, Paul, George and Ringo will ring out from every nook and cranny of the City. Seventy of the finest Beatles tribute bands and fans from all over the world will be here, in Liverpool, with one mission - The Beatles! What a fab return to normality it was last summer during Beatleweek, seeing friends from all over the world with a backdrop of amazing live music from bands from 25 different countries. It really did feel like "International" Beatleweek after the previous two years when many overseas fans could not make their annual pilgrimage to Liverpool. So, it's not surprising that the bookings for 2023 (even before line ups and concepts have been announced) are at record levels. Hotel space is scarce even though there are over a hundred hotels in contrast to just the five that existed when The Beatles Convention first began, all those years ago. The clock is ticking, and I am sure that once you see the plans for 2023 you will be as excited as we are. As always, our programme brings you some familiar faces, favourite bands, and artists, but also many new bands who will play Beatleweek for the very first time. As we write we are sifting through the hundreds of applications to bring you the very best acts from around the world.

We are sure you will like what we have planned for 2023 and we hope to see you here, in Liverpool in the summer.

WEDNESDAY 23rd AUGUST

We kick off our festival on Liverpool's famous Mathew Street, appropriately at the world-famous Cavern Club where the Beatles cut their musical teeth with 292 performances between February 1961 and August 1963. This year's International Beatleweek Festival

marks an incredible 60 years since The Beatles last ever show at The Cavern and it's fair to say they are bigger now than ever, with younger generations continuing to discover the magic of John, Paul, George & Ringo. We will have live music across our two stages in the club and on our third stage, directly over the road in The Cavern Pub. Don't forget, The Cavern Restaurant is located opposite The Cavern and is there to keep you fuelled up between our live acts.

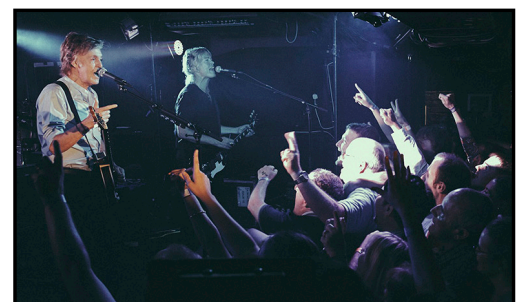

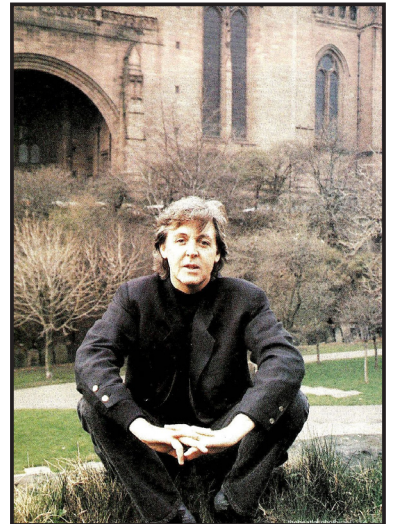

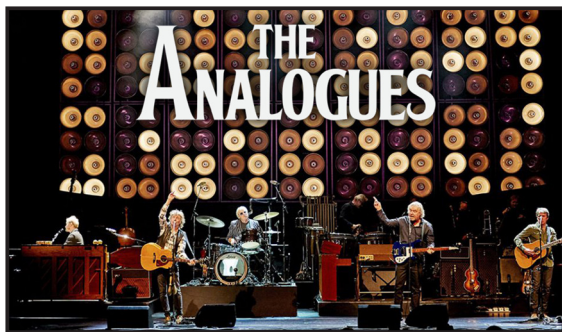
International Beatleweek 2023

25th AUGUST

The theme for Friday is 'Hope of Deliverance'. We are utilising Hope Street in its entirety and delivering a day to remember. The street and area is full of Beatles heritage sights such as Paul and George's school and John's Art college and iconic pubs such as Ye Cracke which has so much Beatles history. The **Philharmonic Pub** was chosen by Paul for a live gig on 9th June 2018 which was televised as part of James Corden's Carpool Karaoke. We will be staging live music in the exact room throughout the day together with four other stages in the **Everyman Theatre** and **Ye Cracke** pub. There are also opportunities either end of the street to visit the amazing Cathedrals (Paul auditioned as a choir boy in the Anglican Cathedral and later staged the Oratorio there). There are lots of restaurants in the area to have dinner before the short stroll to the **Philharmonic Hall** for the evening show.

We are really excited to be hosting an event at Liverpool's new iconic performance space at **The Yoko Ono Lennon Centre**. It is within a ten-minute walk from The Adelphi, and part

of Liverpool University. It was at a meeting with Sean Lennon at the opening of the centre that we realised and decided we simply had to include the venue as part of our 2023 festival. It is a fantastic, new, modern space with lecture theatres, performance spaces, a theatre, bar and outside areas which will be awash with Beatles fans throughout the day. The title of the show is '**UNI Have Memories**' and we will roll out the 'memories' with a mixture of live music, interviews, and films. The venue also boasts a beautiful, world class lecture theatre, where we will have the world's finest Beatles historian

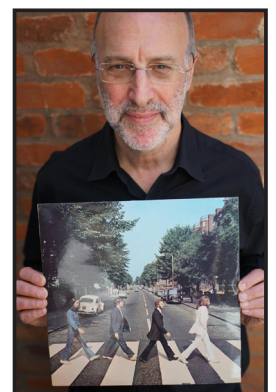
